Melrude Fire Hall: Clerk Cindy Brown asked supervisors what the next steps will be after the special meeting to inform residents of the issue and the recommendation to resolve. They would like the committee to meet one more time to review what they recommended as supervisors Arrlette Krog and Beth Caple are wondering if the recommendation is the best course of action.
